

# Oxygen Administration

This course teaches how to operate various oxygen devices as well as to respond and treat respiratory emergencies. The course is for those who are required to use oxygen in the workplace including lifeguards, emergency medical services (EMS) professionals, etc.

<b>Prerequisite</b>	CPR Level HCP
<b>Completion</b>	100% attendance, skills demonstration, and 80% min. passing grade on written exam
<b>Certification</b>	3-year certification in Oxygen Administration
<b>Recertification</b>	Not permitted under federal regulations
